

Emoji Theater



Level:

Elementary



Objectives:

Student will be able to talk about how people feel in different situations



Timing

5-15 Minutes



Prep/

Materials:

Prepare a list of situations people can get in and prepare corresponding pictures of emoji

- This is a listening/speaking activity, so only give pictures of emoji to the student, so that he has something to choose from
- Prepare a list of situations a person can find himself in. For example:
 - Your best friend's cat has recently died.
 - Your nephew is graduating this year.
 - Your spouse has just received an offer from the company they want to work at.
 - Your boss has just told you can have 5 extra days off.
 - Someone has just bumped your car from the back.



Breakdown:

- You can write as many situations as you would like, depending on how long you want the activity to go on.
- Ask the student to choose an emoji that best describes the feelings of the person in a situation. Ask them to explain the choice.
- It is a good idea to pre-teach feelings and emotions, so that the student is prepared for this activity.
