

# A-Z Vocabulary



Level:

Elementary – Intermediate



Objectives:

The student will be able to expand his vocabulary in a particular topic  
Timing: 15-20 minutes



Timing

15-20 minutes



Prep/

Materials:

A sheet of paper with A-Z written on it (leave enough space for words to be written next to each letter of the alphabet)



Breakdown:

- Choose a topic (depending on what you are teaching your student now) and ask them to write one word related to the topic, starting with each letter of the alphabet.
- For example, the topic can be “jobs”, “adjectives”, etc. If the student has trouble coming up with a word, give a hint to help them. If the word is new for them, define it and put it in a sentence. Letter “X” can be skipped if needed (or be creative and make your own rule for that letter!)
  - A ambitious
  - B bizarre
  - C courageous
  - D divine
  - E energetic
  - ... etc.
