Level:

Elementary – Intermediate



Objectives:

The student will be able to learn more about the teacher and share some information about themselves



Timing

10-15 minutes



Prep/

Materials:

Prepare a list of statements for the student to pick from

- This activity could be used in one of the first lessons as an ice-breaker.
- Cut out the statements and arrange them separately on the table, so that the student can easily read them.
- Choose 5 statements that are true for you (or that you agree with) and ask the student to do the same.
- Read your statements and ask the student to do the same
- Ask further questions on the student's statements; give them a chance to learn more about you as well.



Breakdown:

For example:

I'm easy to get along with.

I like learning grammar.

I like meeting new people.

I don't like being the center of attention.

Harry Potter is overrated.

Motor racing is boring.

I'm excited by new technology.

Smoking should be completely banned.

I have more than 200 Facebook friends.
