

# Add-On Lists



Level:

Beginner/Elementary



Objectives:

The student will practice vocabulary within the given topic and will also train their memory.



Timing

10-15 minutes



Prep/

Materials:

No preparation needed, other than pre-teaching vocabulary on a particular topic.

This activity can be used as a warmer or a brief vocabulary review. Pick a topic (for example, grocery store, furniture, random items, etc). If you pick “Grocery store”, you can start by saying “I went to the store and bought a...” or if you pick “Random items” you can say, “In my Grandma’s attic there is a...” Ask your student to add another item to the list. Make sure they first repeat your item and then add another one. This could be something like “I went to the store and bought a pear and an apple”. Then it’s your turn to add another item to the list. This can go on until someone forgets what items were on the list before.



Breakdown:

A variation could be going through the alphabet. For example, the teacher says, “I like apples”, The student says, “I like apples and bananas...”
