Prepare groups of compound words or collocations which share a common word

- 1. Find a group of compound words or collocations which share a common word. For example, bedroom, bathroom, living room, classroom, showroom, etc.
- 2. Give your student 1 of the word/collocation parts, such as bed and have them guess the missing part. Continue adding to the list by writing bath, living, class, etc. until they successfully guess the word.
- 3. Here are some more examples:
 - ✓ Ear, boxing, diamond, finger, wedding (RING)
 - √ Tea, soup, table, dessert (SPOON)
 - √ Kitchen, tea, bath, beach (TOWEL)
 - ✓ Green, light, ware, boat, work, wife (HOUSE)



If the student does not know the meaning of a collocation, make sure you explain it.
