

# WORD Association



Level:

Pre-Intermediate-Intermediate



Objectives:

the student will be able to practice spontaneous speaking + use their creativity



Timing

15 minutes



Prep/

Materials:

No prep needed

Ask your student to say a word. It can be anything, but for this example, we will say “green”. Then you (in case it is an individual training) or Student 2 (if it is a group) say a word that is related to Student 1’s word - “Grass”. You can then continue around the chain with each student adding a related word to what the previous person has said.

For example: Green—Grass—Lawn—Garden—Tomatoes—Squirrels, etc.

The rules are simple. You may have to be able to explain why a word is related. You also can’t repeat a word that has already been said. To make this one harder you can also include a timer.
