

RESTAURANT REVIEW



Level:

Intermediate-Advanced



Objectives:

the student will be able to write a restaurant review



Timing

30 minutes



Prep/

Materials:

prepare a restaurant review form (to be completed by the student)

Ask the student to visit a restaurant of their choice and write a review; this can be given as a home assignment. After the student visits a restaurant and writes their review, you can go over the questions and their responses and discuss what they liked/disliked, read other reviews about the restaurant, and even post their review to Google or Yelp! A fun writing activity like this may motivate a student to actually do their homework. Here's an example of a restaurant review template:

Describe the décor. (consider the space, lighting, furniture, color, furniture).

Is the staff friendly? Helpful? Knowledgeable?

What did you order? Describe the ingredients in it.

Describe how your food tasted. Was it delicious? Was it terrible? Why?

Rate your restaurant experience. Would you recommend this place to a friend?

How many stars would you give it?
