Class Schedule Role Play





Beginner—Intermediate (Included worksheet would be best for beginning levels but the activity can be adapted for higher levels)

The student will be able to ask and answer relevant questions to gather information in order to schedule a coffee meet-up with friends.

10-20 minutes, can be expanded further into a various levels of difficulty

- Information Gap Worksheet (Example provided includes an activity about class schedules—this can be edited to a work meeting schedule, bus/plane schedule, or any other topic that might be relevant to your student)
- Vocabulary list of words associated with the topic
- 1. Introduce exercise and pre-teach necessary vocabulary and grammar.
- 2. Assign each participant to a role and introduce the "main question" on their worksheet. Practice using the example conversation.
- Breakdown:
- For 1-1 classes, a student and teacher can act as Participant A & B.
- 3. Participants take turns asking each other questions to complete their entire schedule grid with the missing information.
- 4. Once both participants have all of the information, work together to determine the answer to the main question!
- 5. Post Activity Discussion: What challenges did the role play present? Are there different ways to phrase questions or answers? Are there different ways to say a time using different phrases?

Suggestions for more complex exercise:

• Vary the tense practice, conduct role play as past or future or create conditional questions to add to the scenario.
