Objectives:

Beginner—Intermediate, can be adapted for higher levels

The student will be able to ask specific questions to gather enough information to guess your "secret identity"



Timing



15-20 minutes, can be expanded further into a various levels of difficulty

- Select a few different celebrities, historical or cultural figures, as the subject of the activity; write up a short profile of each person with a few facts
- Note, celebrities do not have to be current pop culture figures, you may consider selecting historical or cultural figures that are prominent in the student's host country.
- Prepare pre-teaching material to introduce any relevant vocabulary or grammar needed to discuss the celebrity & their area of interest.
- Create 10-15 questions associated with the celebrity profile
- 1. Pre-teach new vocabulary or specific grammatical targets—review the prepared questions as examples that your student can use
- 2. Introduce each of the celebrities and historical or cultural icons; discuss the significance of their contributions to the world
- 3. The teacher then selects a celebrity profile (but does not share the profile with the student) and "acts" as that person for the rest of the activity
- 4. The student role is to ask specific questions in order to gather enough information to guess which celebrity the teacher is portraying
- 5. Depending upon the role the teacher is portraying, you may answer questions in a formal or informal manner, ask follow-up questions, etc.
- 6. Repeat for each celebrity/cultural icon, you can even switch roles!
