## Leave a Message after the Beep





Beginner-Intermediate



The student will be able to convey a verbal message quickly & succinctly over the phone.



5-10 minutes, can be expanded depending on students level



No preparation needed, both student & teacher should have access to a phone with voicemail capability.



The student will use their real phone to call the instructor and leave a voicemail. The student can call back if they'd like to rephrase something or try something else. The topics below are just ideas, choose something that is relevant to your students life & the vocabulary they're learning!



## **Topic Ideas:**

- 1. Family picnic: Have the students ask a family member if they would like to go to a family gathering at the park. The student can provide small details of the gathering and what time the function will start.
- 2. Phone Tag: The student will call someone back to find the call once again went to voicemail. The student can say they are calling back and would love to connect soon, etc.
- 3. Checking in at home: Have the student pretend they are leaving a voicemail to someone at home. The topics could include: The student just leaving work, arriving late, picking up groceries, and/or reminding the person at home that they have an event that evening.
