

# Scrabble Games in Many Ways



Level:

Beginner—Intermediate, can be adapted for higher levels



Objectives:

The board game, Scrabble, is officially issued in 22 languages, from Afrikaans to Zhuyin. The student will be able to learn different ways to play scrabble in order to improve different skills such as: vocabulary, spelling practice, letter groupings, number writing, and dictionary practice.



Timing

5-15 minutes, can be expanded further into a variety of approaches.



Prep/

Materials:

- A Scrabble Board Game (visit your Amazon site to purchase a specific language)
- Online Version, there are a few different sites to consider: <https://www.online-tech-tips.com/cool-websites/5-best-sites-to-play-scrabble-online-with-friends/>

1. Together with the student, discuss the game, the rules and the approach that you have selected.
2. Review spelling words or letter groupings (English examples: words that begin with sh, ch)
3. As each word is played, discuss the word and have them complete a practice exercise, for example:
  - Create a sentence with the word,
  - Create a sentence in a specific tenses with the word,
  - List 1 or 2 synonyms or antonyms for the played word
  - Use a dictionary to discuss alternate definitions of the word
