Level:

Beginner—Intermediate, can be adapted for higher levels



Objectives:

The student will be able to practice listening and speaking skills as they participate with online games and/or the gaming world.

- Review the website resources and select an appropriate game:
 - You can practice a grammar skill by using a game like Battleship
 - OR you can choose to just play a game to practice the language needed for that fun task!
- Prepare a list of gaming terms to review with the student, for example: your turn, you're up, we're tied, you win, good game, we'll get em' next time, etc.



Breakdown:

1. Introduce the gaming topic and pre-teach new terms
2. Review any relevant reading materials and discuss the features of various games, the rules of the game you will play, and the connection to the grammar/vocabulary needed to play the game.
3. Play a game with your student (for example: Checkers or Battleship) OR
4. Learn a video gamer's game together (for example: Fortnite or Minecraft).
The student can show you around their world in the game, describing what they see and what they like to do!
