Ingredient Randomizer





Beginner—Intermediate

The student will be able to practice food vocabulary, recognize ingredients that make up a dish, and practice creating sentences.

Materials:

- 1. To warm up, show the Food Vocabulary ESL Video (or another video) and discuss food generally in the home and host culture.
- 2. Have your student list their favorite dishes or foods and review any relevant food vocabulary that comes from that list.
- 3. As the student lists food items, type up a list of the ingredients they mention in an online tool like this <u>list randomizer</u>.
- 4. Use the randomizer to select one ingredient at a time, for each ingredient that the randomizer chooses, have the student create a sentence about what dishes can be made with that ingredient, how to prepare it, etc.
- 5. Make sure to encourage your student to incorporate grammar that is relevant to their current level—you could require their sentences, for example, to include commands, specific tenses, prepositions, etc.
