Safety Preparedness Role Play







Objectives:

Beginner—Intermediate

The student will be able to practice emergency and urgent care requests and practice role playing emergency scenarios.



- Prepare a vocabulary list of emergency-related words, for example: police, hospital, fire station, help, fire, car crash, bicycle, moped, hurt, broken, etc.
- Create 2 or 3 role play scenario prompts. Please note: some of these topics
 can be sensitive or upsetting for your student, so pay close attention to your
 student for any signs of discomfort and move on if necessary.
 - Calling for help while walking down the street, asking strangers to assist in an emergency
 - Mobile call for an ambulance for someone's broken ankle
 - Mobile call for police to assist in a car crash



- 1. Discuss different types of emergencies that may occur, using the new vocabulary in context to show it's meaning
- 2. Introduce the vocabulary list and discuss meaning
- 3. Work together with the student to prepare a list of important details and emergency names, numbers and locations:
 - Student's details: name, mobile number, address, nearest cross street, languages student speaks
 - Emergency number (ex: 911), hospital name, address, phone number, police station address, phone number, fire station address, phone number
- 4. Talk through each of the role play scenarios
